Painting with Tools

Supplies

- Paper – the bigger the better
- Painter's or masking tape
- Kitchen utensils (like a spatula, vegetable brush, fork, or whisk)
- Tools (like a screwdriver or a hammer)
- *Optional:* Nuts and bolts
- Paint in various colors
- Plates for the paint

Instructions

1. If you can, let your child find and choose the tools they want to use as "paintbrushes."
2. Lay out the paper and tape the edges to the work surface. On a table! Or the floor! Or outside on the pavement! Or in a dry bathtub!
3. Put out enough paint so one surface of the tool can be fully coated in paint.
4. Paint!
